## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

This is the final report I will be presenting as President of the South Port Surf Life Saving Club Inc. I have been very honoured to hold the position for the past 12 years.

We have seen many changes to the Club in that time:

The construction of the joint Mid Coast storage sheds on W.M. Hunt Reserve on River Road that allowed the existing shed on Wearing Street to be converted to our gym and shared storage facility with the South Port Rowing Club.

We had protracted discussions with the Onkaparinga City Council over the signing of a lease agreement for the Club house building; previously we were responsible for all up keep and maintenance on the building, and this was achieved.

Finally the building of the extension to the Club, this has been by far the most beneficial to us, and I would like to thank Bob Mayo AM once again for his generous support financially to this project. The \$200K gave us the ability to progress from pipedream to reality. The Facility Management Group (SA Govt) contribution of \$208K, plus over \$100K of club money and we were fortunate to get a grant of \$10K from Amanda Rishworth's office, this enabled the kitchen and bar area to be completed as well.

Don Alexander's time and effort cannot be over stated in the whole build; quite simply it would not be complete without his time and dedication to the project.

There have been management changes, these were not undertaken lightly they will be ongoing and I think if people persevere they will benefit the club as a whole unit, not separate entities. It is very important that members understand we are ONE club not many factions operating separately to our own goals. Just one Club!

There are many members to thank for their efforts this season, I'm not going to name anyone but suffice it to say a big thankyou to those members that put in a fantastic effort to run the senior carnivals this season and the Senior States. I would like to thank the committee from this season it has been a tough one for many reasons but they answered the challenges well.

In closing this report I will repeat something I wrote in 2013, there are a couple of things that I think are most important and would like people to take on board, we are part of a volunteer organisation, we all give time for varying reasons and should be striving to achieve the same goals, no one individual is bigger than the club and if we all try our hardest to make the best decisions for the right reasons then there should be no grounds for complaint and that decision will not be hard to justify, think before you speak, and lets not take the fun out of what we do and enjoy.

Bronze Medal at the Australian Titles to Simon Linden & Ian Price in the 60-64 Double Ski Event.


Maintained our Level 3 Good Sports Accreditation.

## TREASURER'S REPORT

The summarised report on income, expenditure and trading for the season 2015-16 have been taken from the 2016 Audit conducted by PCS Accountants (formally Edward Jeynes), which is included as Annexure "A".

Our income increased over the previous period, due to a number of factors and individual efforts over a range of portfolios, including the bar, canteen, membership, fundraising and junior activities.

The general feeling at the Club throughout the season was very positive and even though there were some challenging times, most got on with the job at hand and this is reflected in the financial report.

Once again David "Wal" Watt, as Club House Manager, led the way with a fantastic effort with bar trading producing a gross profit of \$62,522. With the completion of the extension and finally having a commercial kitchen, we have experienced increased demand for the venue to be booked for various social activities by club and non-club members. Thanks also to Tracy Kille and Carla Zeitz for their assistance in running the coffee machine at carnivals and other special events.

Michelle Copley's contribution, not only in her general role as Secretary, but also in assisting me in my role has been exceptional. Michelle is always thinking of how we can all do things better to improve the overall processes of the administration of the Club. One of the most positive of these was the processing the membership through SLSA's Members Portal and over \$40,000 in membership fees.

Yvonne Olesinski, returned another good result in the canteen. We are extremely grateful for her involvement in the canteen, which over a number of years has contributed \$93,909 during the period from 2001 to 2016, a wonderful effort. Yvonne has mentioned that this is her last year in the role as canteen manager but I'm hoping that she will still be assisting us in another area in the coming season.

Laura Greer put in another terrific year with fundraising, while the income was just around \$10,000, this doesn't reflect the true value of contribution as most of the events she ran had a positive impact on bar turnover.

A special thanks to all members who donated their time to help behind the bar, in the canteen, running raffles and fundraising. To those who assisted at carnivals in work parties, cooking the BBQ, or preparing meals for the carnival officials, many thanks.

## NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 APRIL 2016

The financial statements cover SOUTH PORT S.L.S.C as an individual entity. SOUTH PORT S.L.S.C is a not for profit Association incorporated in the Australian Capital Territory under the Associations Incorporation Act (ACT) 1991 ('the Act').

The functional and presentation currency SOUTH PORT S.L.S.C is Australian dollars. Comparatives are consistent with prior years, unless otherwise stated.

### 1 Basis of preparation

In the opinion of the Committee of Management, the Association is not reporting entity since there are unlikely to exist users of the financial report who are not able to command the preparation of reports tailored so as to satisfy specifically all of their information needs. These special purpose financial statements have been prepared to meet the reporting requirements of the Act.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement requirements of the Australian Accounting Standards and Accounting Interpretations, and the disclosure requirements of AASB 101 Presentation of Financial Statements, AASB 107 Statement of Cash Flows, AASB 108 Accounting Policies, Changes in Accounting Estimates and Errors and AASB 1054 Australian Additional Disclosures.

Significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are presented below and are consistent with prior reporting periods unless otherwise stated. The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historical costs modified, where applicable, by the measurement at fair value of selected non current assets, financial assets and financial liabilities.

### 2 Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

#### Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost of inventory is determined using the first-in-first-out basis and are net of any rebates and discounts received.

#### Plant and Equipment

Plant and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment of losses. Plant and equipment is depreciated on a straight line basis over the assets useful life to the Association, commencing when the asset is ready for use.

The depreciable amount of all plant and equipment is depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the Association commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

## NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 APRIL 2016

### **Impairment of Non-Financial Assets**

At the end of each reporting period the association determines whether there is an evidence of an impairment indicator for non-financial assets.

Where this indicator exists and regardless for goodwill, indefinite life intangible assets and intangible assets not yet available for use, the recoverable amount of the assets is estimated.

Where assets do not operate independently of other assets, the recoverable amount of the relevant cash-generating unit (CGU) is estimated.

The recoverable amount of an asset or CGU is the higher of the fair value less costs of disposal and the value in use. Value in use is the present value of the future cash flows expected to be derived from an asset or cash-generating unit.

Where the recoverable amount is less than the carrying amount, an impairment loss is recognised in profit or loss.

Reversal indicators are considered in subsequent periods for all assets which have suffered an impairment less, except for goodwill.

### **Cash and Cash Equivalents**

Cash and cash equivalents comprises cash on hand, demand deposits and short term investments which are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of change in value.

**Revenue and Other Income**

Revenue is recognised when the amount of the revenue can be measured reliably, it is probable that economic benefits associated with the transaction will flow to the association and specific criteria relating to the type of revenue as noted below, has been satisfied.

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable and is presented net of returns, discounts and rebates.

**Sale of goods**

Revenue is recognised on transfer of goods to the customer as this is deemed to be the point in time when risks and rewards are transferred and there is no longer any ownership or effective control over the goods.

**Interest revenue**

Interest revenue is recognised using the effective interest rate method.

**Interest revenue**

Revenue in relation to rendering of services is recognised depends on whether the outcome of the services can be estimated reliably. If the outcome can be estimated reliably then the stage of completion of the services is used to determine the appropriate level of revenue to be recognised in the period. If the outcome cannot be reliably estimated then revenue is recognised to the extent of expenses recognised that are recoverable.

Revenue from training services is generally recognised once the training has been delivered.


