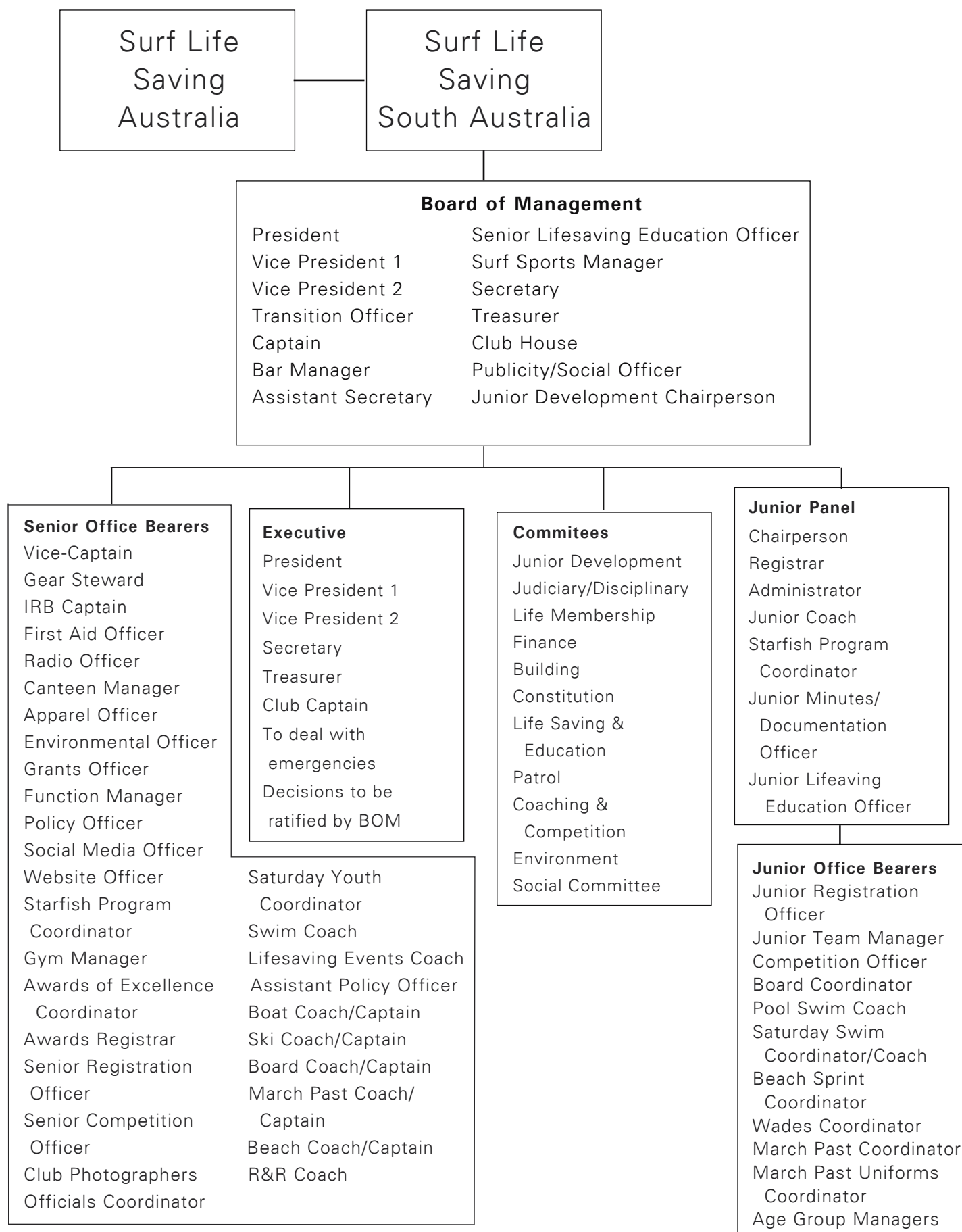

In fact, 18 lives were saved by our members and a substantial increase in preventative actions, this being over 1300 persons stopped from endangering themselves.

This enabled us to again fulfil our Mission: 'To maintain South Port Beach as a safe and enjoyable environment for the general public and our members.'

Many thanks to all our patrolling members that continued to ensure our high standard of patrolling and keeping South Port Beach safe for all swimmers, surfers and visitors.

As reported last season, our patrols will continue to be challenged with increased local population growth and it's more than evident that many more community members are already making South Port their beach to visit and enjoy.

Our patrol statistics continue to substantiate the need for us to be where we are and for ALL of us, the challenges to ensure that we remain sustainable into the future.

There were numerous highlights over our past 60th Anniversary season and many thanks to members for the many hours put in by our volunteers – to all, thank you for your commitment to your Club.

For me, major highlights included:



## SECRETARY REPORT – SEASON 2019/20

Well, it has certainly been a rollercoaster ride throughout our Diamond Jubilee 60th Anniversary season that provided many highs before being derailed by the COVID-19 pandemic and cutting our season agonisingly short! We still had so much to enjoy though.

We celebrated the foundation of our wonderful Club, starting with a brilliant 60th Anniversary get together in October at the Club that saw many past and present members gather to reminisce and pay tribute to the rich history and culture that makes South Port SLSC so special.

### Membership

Numbers significantly increased this season, with a Club record of 487 being reached, which is up from 459 last season (2018/19). The previous Club record of 473 was achieved in the 2015/16 season.

### **"Change is the only constant in life." Heraclitus**

The financial year for the Club ran from 1 May 2019 to 30 April 2020 with the 2020 Audit conducted by PCS Accounting and financial reports are tabled in Annexure "A".

The audited financial operating profit for 2019/20 was \$115,928, an increase of \$59,280 from the previous financial year.

This is largely attributed to a remarkably successful year in securing grant funding of an extra \$45,000 on previous years (\$72,712 in total). Thank you to Richard Olesinski and Maggie Botha for their dedication, hard work and persistence.

Sponsors, donors and fundraising in its many forms yet again provided a welcome and valued support to our Club. Without them we would not be able to upgrade and improve our Club and services to the community.

Amounts received \$5,000+ include:

- City of Onkaparinga
- Stronger Communities Program
- Communities Environment Program
- Kanini Pty Ltd (SLSSA Trust Fund)
- Surf Life Saving Australia

Cash and cash equivalents 30th April 2020 were \$266,926.

With sales of \$101,089 and cost of goods \$47,945, the bar made a profit of \$54,119. This was a slight decrease from the previous year but reflects the ceasing of trade in March due to the Covid-19 pandemic restrictions including the cancellation of several functions. Opening stock was \$5,505 with closing stock \$6,480. Thank you to Marsha Smith and all our RSA certified members for volunteering their time to keep this money maker profitable.

The canteen concluded the season with a profit of \$4,744 (sales \$7,748, cost of goods \$3,034). Thanks to Yvonne Olesinski, Donna Logan, and Rose Orr for their tireless work.

Apparel made what I believe to be record sales of \$20,524, against purchases of \$21,880, with opening stock at \$4,442 and closing stock on hand (at sale value) of \$12,175, profit made was \$6,377. Well done Sally Botha for an amazing achievement.

It should be noted that there is a difference in the method of calculating stock on hand value between the Apparel/Canteen and Bar items. This was advised to the Auditor without prejudice. It is the Clubs intention to ensure that a cost method is implemented for future years.

## TREASURER'S REPORT CONT...

Expenditure has increased this season mainly due to costs associated with purchases of new vehicles, an increase in the number of carnival competitors (mainly Nippers), a growing Juniors Division and fundraising costs associated with our 60Th Anniversary.

Purchases for the year included a new Club Ute, SSV [ATV] Commander, Second-hand Surf Boat, a Defibrillator, various lifesaving and competition equipment, and storage solutions.

I am pleased to report that the Club is solvent.

In my first year as Treasurer I certainly had big shoes to fill. It has been a steep learning curve but one that I have enjoyed and endured. It has taken time to understand the previous system and, in some cases, there are variances. I am confident after Audit and seeking advice from State Centre that although individual line differences exist the overall position of the Club is strong.

There have been several substantial changes this year particularly with the implementation of Square, changing of bank accounts and the Covid-19 pandemic. I look forward to further improvements with Xero, new eCommerce platform and communication between these systems to streamline the role further.

Thank you to all Members for your understanding and patience.

Last but certainly not least, thank you to all who have helped me during the year, but I would like to make special thanks to Don Alexander, Anna Fisher and Sharryn Campbell for their valued knowledge and support.

The 2019/2020 Patrol Season was again a successful and safe season with no lives lost. We completed over 3620 Patrol hours, had 18 rescues, over 1310 Preventative Actions with over 15,500 visitors to beach. All patrols performed well, and it was great seeing more new faces along with the return of some old salty ones.

Thank you to everyone who has helped patrol our beach this season. Due to the COVID-19 virus It has been a long and trying season, but we have made it through, and we are better placed for next season. 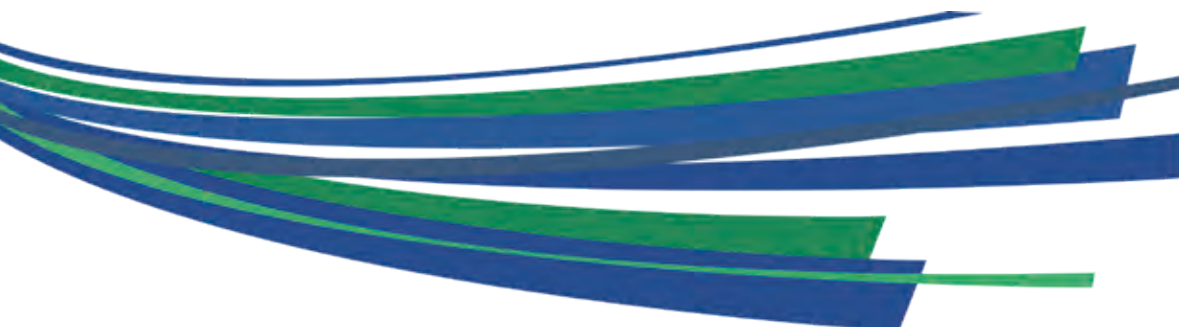

## ENVIRONMENT (ECOSURF) REPORT

Over the past season, the Club's Environmental Committee continued to help and guide members at looking at ways of protecting our playground; the beach we look after from a lifesaving perspective.

One major focus this past season was the Plastic Free program which looked to remove banned single use plastics including straws, stirrers and cutlery. Items that we had already dealt with removing, eg, STRAWS SUCK AT SOUTH PORT SURF CLUB, saw the Club change from plastic to paper straws.

The Committee also looked into the Workplace Health and Safety (WHS) scene through SLISA's 'Safer Surf Club' program. The Club is looking to change WHS to what's common in the corporate sector, particularly the construction industry, HSE, (Health, Safety and Environment). The aim is to focus on the environment as part of improving our safety and well-being.

The Club continues to look at ways to raise member awareness about impacts on the local environment, particularly with discarded litter, and not only on our beaches, but at home, where litter deposited kms away ends up in drains and on our coastlines.

The Keeping South Port Litter Free project over the past season seen us receive an Australian Government Community Environment grant supported by our local Federal Government MP, Amanda Rishworth.

The initiative seen us receive two large Keeping South Port Litter Free sunshades which were used by our Junior members each Saturday. It was also a visual promotion to the local community that litter is not welcome at South Port and to use bins provided.

The litter reduction message was reinforced through regular on-beach clean up efforts of our Juniors and parents which aimed at keeping South Port Beach free from litter.

As part of the Keeping South Port Litter Free project, messages were also included on age group feathers used to help organise our Juniors each Saturday.

The litter reduction message will continue to be delivered in the future and will form part of the Junior's weekly training programs.

**FRANK HARRIS****1936 - 2019**

Club Foundation Member, first Club Captain and Life Member, Frank Harris passed way last October aged 83.

The Harris Family farewelled Frank at a private funeral and the Club hosted an afternoon tea on Sunday 17 November where members told a few yarns and recalled their experiences with Frank over the years.

In 1976/77 Season a March Past Team was formed around the boat crew and other members. During that period to 1982 Bob Mayo AM marched in the pennant with Frank selected in the Belt position. South Port and Seacliff shared the points at Carnivals with the breakthrough State Title occurring in 1983. Frank's decision to appoint Bob as coach was pivotal to the team's success in the ensuing years. From that point on the team continued to win State Titles with Bob as coach with Frank as Pennant Bearer. In 1985 with Frank as Pennant Bearer the team became the first SA group to be placed in Australian Titles in the 'blue ribbon' march past event. Success followed with further Australian Bronze Medals in 1986 and 1987. The team with Frank as Pennant Bearer continued to achieve podium finishes at the Australian Titles until finally the might of the eastern states was cracked in 1995 (10 years after the bronze) with the inaugural Australian Title won at Kurrawa Queensland. A number of Australian Titles and a world Title were achieved with Frank 'leading the charge' as Pennant Bearer. Frank was an integral part of the team until his retirement in 2006, after winning an Australian Title as a 70 year old. He retired with 7 Australian Titles, a World Title and many State Titles. Frank was a genuine 'sand warrior'.

#### 1 Basis of preparation

In the opinion of the Committee of Management, the association is not a reporting entity since there are unlikely to exist users of the financial statements who are not able to command the preparation of reports tailored so as to satisfy specifically all of their information needs. These special purpose financial statements have been prepared to meet the reporting requirements of the Act.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement requirements of the Australian Accounting Standards and Accounting Interpretations, and the disclosure requirements of AASB 101 Presentation of Financial Statements, AASB 107 Statement of Cash Flows, AASB 108 Accounting Policies, Changes in Accounting Estimates and Errors and AASB 1054 Australian Additional Disclosures.

#### **Sale of goods**

Revenue is recognised on transfer of goods to the customer as this is deemed to be the point in time when risks and rewards are transferred and there is no longer any ownership or effective control over the goods.

#### **Interest revenue**

Interest is recognised using the effective interest method.

#### **Cash and cash equivalents**

Cash and cash equivalents comprises cash on hand, demand deposits and short-term investments which are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of change in value.

#### **Property, plant and equipment**

Each class of property, plant and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment.

Property, plant and equipment is depreciated on a straight-line basis over the asset's useful life to the Association, commencing when the asset is ready for use.

#### **Inventories**

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost of inventory is determined using the first-in-first-out basis and is net of any rebates and discounts received. Net realisable value is estimated using the most reliable evidence available at the reporting date and inventory is written down through an obsolescence provision if necessary.

#### **Impairment of non-financial assets**

The recoverable amount of an asset or CGU is the higher of the fair value less costs of disposal and the value in use. Value in use is the present value of the future cash flows expected to be derived from an asset or cash-generating unit.

Where the recoverable amount is less than the carrying amount, an impairment loss is recognised in profit or loss.

Reversal indicators are considered in subsequent periods for all assets which have suffered an impairment loss, except for goodwill.




