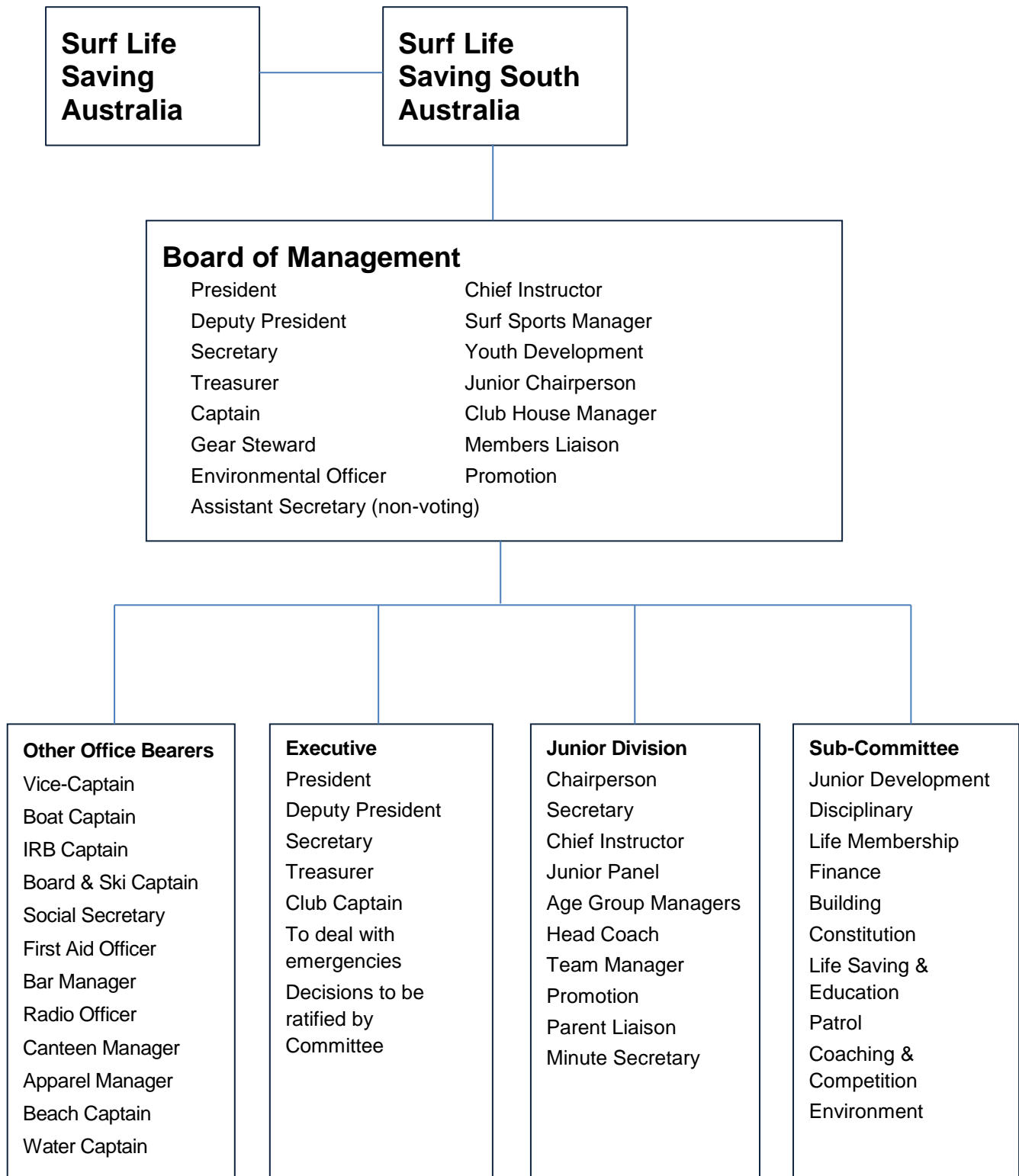

Management Structure

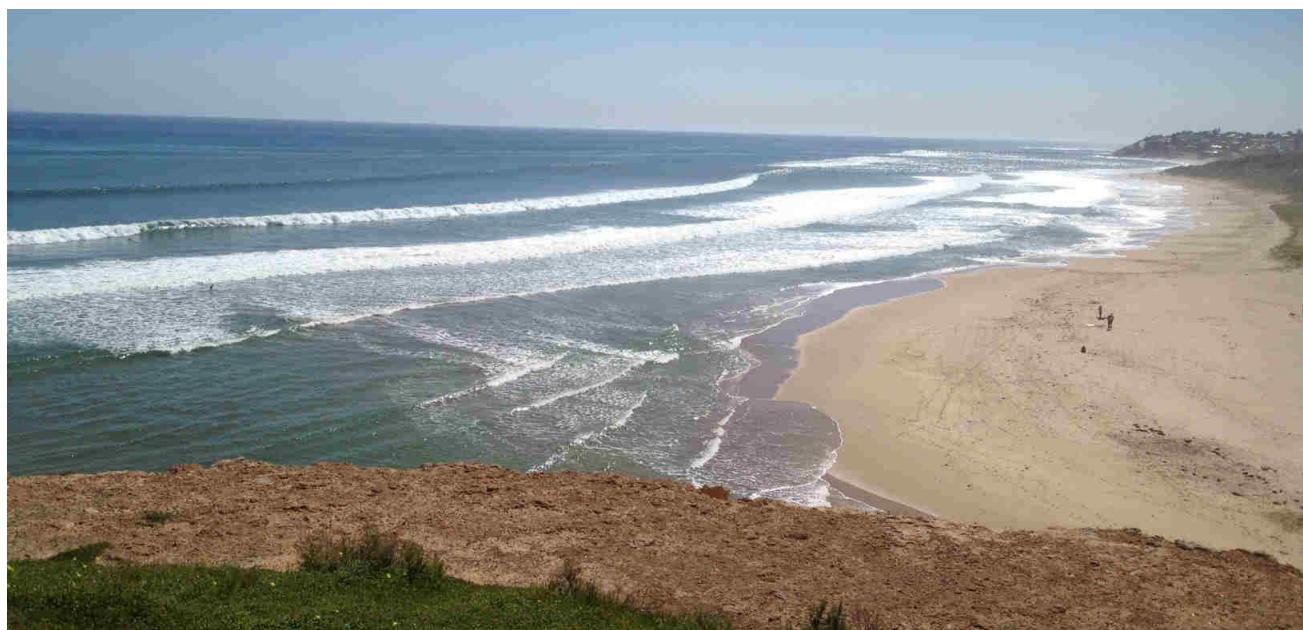

The work and the time that you people do is a credit to you and the Club is all the better for your efforts and much of this goes on behind the overall operations of the Club and is not noticed. A special thanks to Graham Joyce for his work in organising the BBQ's at the Beach Road markets, Graham has done an exceptional job in putting this together again this year, and to Mel Broad for getting the Bunnings BBQ up and going and hanging in there all day to raise in excess of \$1500 for the day.

I would like to thank the many Club, National and State sponsors as they make our financial viability so much easier.

John Smith

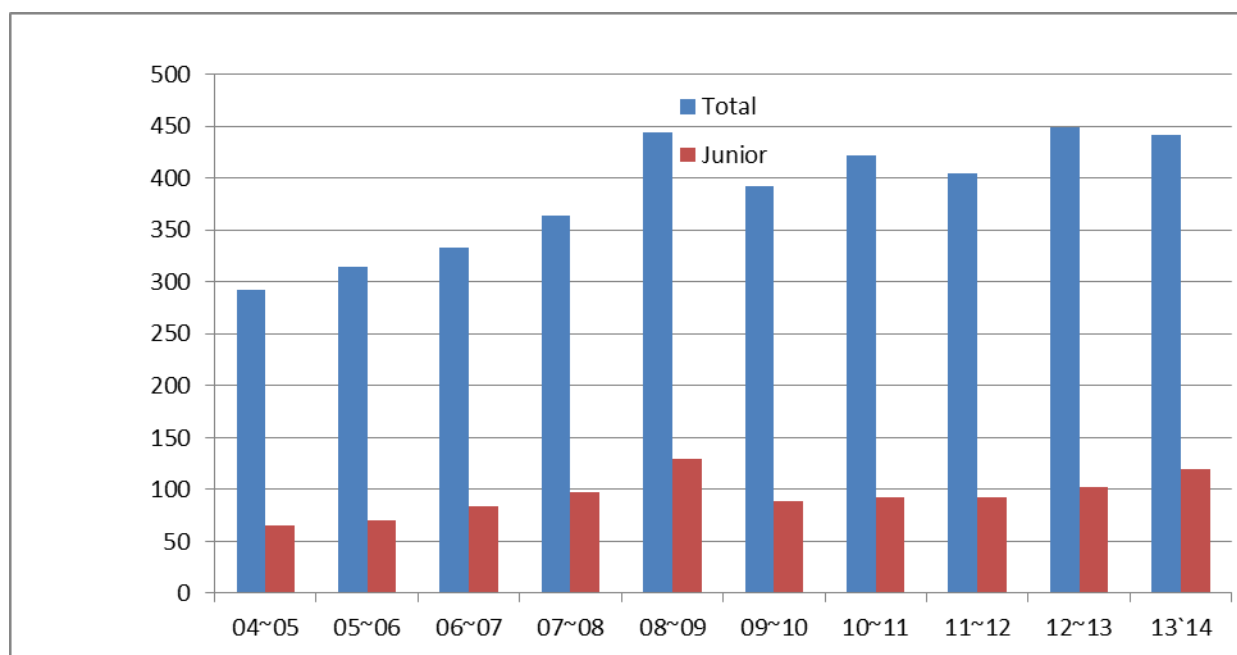
Well I had big shoes to try and fill this season following on from John Smith and I was thinking that if I could do the job just half as good as him, then I would be OK. The amount of work that goes on behind the scenes to make sure that South Port is what it is, is a credit to everyone involved.

Some highlights of the season include:

- South Port members patrolled for a total of 3710 hours
- The approval of the new building extension and surf boat by our members
- Silver Medal at the Australian Titles to the March Past Team and Denis (Congo) Ferrett in the 70+ Tube Swim
- 22 Bronze Medallions 17 Surf Rescue Certificates 19 ATV Operators Certificates
- 5th overall at Senior State Titles
- The Shivering Shags donating \$2000 towards the Junior Craft Purchasing Programme
- Shivering Shags had 45 financial members
- Maintained our Level 3 Good Sports Accreditation

Membership

This season our total membership showed a slight decrease, from 449 last season to 442 this season. The Juniors continue to show an increase in numbers from 102 last year to 120 this year, an increase of 17.6%.

Treasurer's Report

Don "Bristles" Alexander

The summarised report on income, expenditure and trading for the season 2013-2014 have been taken from the 2014 Audit conducted by Edward Jaynes, which is included as Annexure "A".

Cash on hand at the end of the financial year totalled \$254,836. This was mainly due to an extremely generous donation from Bob Mayo totalling \$200,000 over the past two years. These funds from Bob are now in a separate account to be used exclusively for the clubhouse extension. The remaining funds include an amount of \$30,000-for the purchase of a new surf boat, due to arrive late August 2014.

In general, income was on par with the previous season but as can be seen from the breakdown not a lot changed over the previous season; a good result considering that we didn't hold any State Championships. Our profit from trading continues to be the main contributor to our income stream, with all three areas recording a positive result totalling \$50,967; a record result for the Club. Special thanks to David 'Wal' Watt, Club House Manager for his contribution throughout the year, both in the bar and the club house. Yvonne Olesinski, returned another good result in the canteen and also played a major role in returning a small profit to the clothing section; we are extremely grateful for her involvement once again. A special thanks to all members who donated their time to help behind the counter on the weekends and special occasions, your assistance is much appreciated.

On the expenditure side, our total costs remained at the same level as the previous year. Tour team expenses were up but balanced out on the income side by funding received from payments and travel subsidies. Vehicle, Registration and Insurance was up mainly due to repairs and depreciation and premises were lower than the previous year.

The Club received Grants from the City of Onkaparinga Council for \$10,774, \$9,000 from Kahini Pty Ltd (SLSSA Trust Fund) and \$5,000 from Recreation and Sport for a total of \$24,774.

This season has been very successful again in all areas the club competed in.

Well done to the boat area with a Gold to the 'Shooters' [Open Female] and a Silver to the 'Snappers' [Open Male] and also to the outstanding March Past crew who added another Gold to their achievements.

There were changes in the Board/Ski/Swim squad this year with my focus shifting to quality and not quantity of competitors. It was another good season in the boat area for the South Port Surf Club, with both a men's and women's crew representing the State in the Open Divisions, and both of those crews also gained selection from the SA ASRL to be 2 of the 4 crews to represent SA in the Triple Crown events (held in Qld, NSW and Vic).

Our other Open Women's crew were almost selected for the State Team as well, only narrowly missing out behind the Shooters for that spot. That crew (the Sprockets) also competed outstandingly all season, with Brad Vogt guiding them well throughout the whole summer (and winter pre-season). Unfortunately they were a bit unlucky at the State Titles, but it was a good year all round for the Sprockets.

A big highlight of the year was with the Shooters at the 2nd Triple Crown Event in Anglesea Victoria, as they took out the event on the Saturday's racing which was against some highly regarded women's crews from all over Australia.

Both the Shooters and the Snappers represented the club well at the Aussies in Perth, with both crews making the quarter finals (the final 24 crews). There was also an unfortunate event for the Shooters who should have gone through to the next final, however both crews rowed extremely well whilst competing, and they were right on the pace with many a crew who made it through to the pointy end of racing on Sunday."

Following the very successful 2012-13 season during which the old team reformed (after retiring in 2010), and was successful in defending its World Title and winning another Australian Title, that team decided to pursue a further Australian Title in 2014.

The team was motivated to do this in the hope that the Club might finally receive the official recognition of the team being inducted into the SLSA Hall of Fame. Members will recall, that in 2010 the South Port March Past team was listed on the SLSA web site as the team having been inducted into the SLSA Hall of Fame only to be told that this was a mistake.

The team agreed on a training regime that suited their individual commitments. They were successful at all of the local carnivals, including the State Titles, with zero points deducted. Accommodation and travel arrangements were made well in advance and high hopes were held for success in Perth. Unfortunately Simon Simms became seriously ill on the flight over and this was exacerbated when at the first training session his knee gave way (which will require surgery) Simon spent the rest of the carnival in a wheel chair, but continued to give great support to the team.

What to do? Simon marched on the near side front handle, an extremely important position. After considering various alternatives the coach phoned Stephen Clohesy in Adelaide who fortunately was able to secure a flight to Perth which arrived on Saturday morning. Robin Atkinson changed from his usual position to Simons and Stephen took over Robins. We were able to train twice on Saturday and whilst the team presented extremely well and entered the competition confidently, there is no doubt these late changes made the challenge greater.

Unfortunately we were beaten narrowly into second place by Burning Palms.

Whilst it is yet to be finally resolved it is encouraging that the team overwhelmingly have expressed an inclination to pursue a further Title in 2015, particularly to commemorate to 30th year from winning our first Bronze Medal and the 20th year since achieving our first Gold.

Thanks to the untiring efforts and organisation of the Coach, Bob Mayo and also Robert Perry for his dedicated communication dialogue with all team members. We are also appreciative of David Gardiner's undertaking to assist with the high cost of getting Stephen to Perth at such short notice.

Don 'Bristles' Alexander is a Foundation Member of the South Port Surf Life Saving Club when the club was originally formed in 1959. In 1975, he was bestowed with Life Membership due to his ongoing commitment to the club during its formative years.

An interstate move forced him to move away in 1976 and he returned again in 1999.

In 1999/2000, he took up the position of Club Treasurer, a position he has held to this time.

'Bristles' contributions are more far reaching than as an expert and highly credible administrator, but as a competitive surf boat competitor, mentor and coach. He has been the successful in winning numerous State Surfboat Championships.

He competed in the nation's top competitive level, up to last season, and his Open Women's crew have been the state's highest achieving crew two out of the past three Australian Championships, three since 2008.

Not only has 'Bristles' volunteered his administrative expertise at club level but he has also been the Australian Surf Rower's League SA (ASRL SA) State Treasurer for the past 15 years. In 2010 he was inducted into the ASRL SA's Hall of Fame for his contribution to surf rowing.

He has been the Australian Surf Rower's League National Treasurer since 2009. His guidance within the national arena has seen the national body's financial standing greatly increase and is currently at the best level ever since the League commenced in 1997.

His commitment to surf life saving has also seen him volunteer his time at state organisational level being inaugural Chairman of Surf Life Saving SA's Board of Surf Sports from 1994 – 2010. He is well respected by Surf Life Saving SA for his knowledge, innovation and guidance of the sporting aspect of the organisation.

Don 'Bristles' Alexander is an inspiration to South Port members and his commitment as an administrator in the role of Treasurer at club, state and national level makes 'Bristles' a great role model to members of surf clubs and the community in general.
